## Safety and Risk Factors Reported By Victims

 of people receiving advocacy services reported the perpetrator used a weapon, including a firearm against the victim.of people receiving advocacy services reported the victim missed time from work/school and/or a loss of income as a result of sexual violence.
$76 \%$ of people receiving advocacy services who have been assaulted within the past 30 days who reported the presenting sexual violence experience to police.

## Impact of Services Provided

$74 \%$ of hotline callers reported the services received were helpful.
