

18% of people receiving advocacy services reported the perpetrator used a weapon, including a firearm against the victim.

23% of people receiving advocacy services had to relocate or became homeless as a result of domestic violence.

75% of people receiving advocacy services who have been assaulted within the past 30 days who reported the presenting domestic violence experience to police


78% of hotline callers reported the services received were helpful.


