



Safety and Risk Factors Reported By Victims

21% of people receiving advocacy services reported the perpetrator used a weapon, including a firearm against the victim.

- 20% of people receiving advocacy services reported the victim missed time from work/school and/or a loss of income as a result of sexual violence.
- 72% of people receiving advocacy services who have been assaulted within the past 30 days who reported the presenting sexual violence experience to police.

Impact of Services Provided

81% of hotline callers reported the services received were helpful.

80% of people who reported sexual violence had an impact on their emotional/mental well-being received counseling/advocacy services.
